

## Obituary Alfred E. Davidson III '51

Alfred E. "Ted" Davidson of Barrington, Illinois died on February 10, 2016 after a long battle with muscular dystrophy. His wife Ellie died in 2015 and a son also predeceased him. Surviving are three children, two grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.

Ted lived most of his life in north suburban Chicago. He spent his entire working career with Patent Scaffold Company, founded by his grandfather, where he served as operations manager. In retirement he and Ellie lived in Florida before returning to a continuing care community in Barrington.

He was a dedicated volunteer for organizations serving the needs of youth, among them the Wilmette Teen Center where he was a long time board member and treasurer. He was recognized by New Trier Township for his work with youth. He and Ellie were also very active in their church.

At Dartmouth Ted was a member of Sigma Phi Epsilon fraternity and the Dartmouth Players. He earned an MBA degree from the Tuck School.

Ted's father, Alfred E. Davidson, was a member of Dartmouth's class of 1922.
