OBITUARY BAYARD W. JOHNSTON

Bayard Johnston died on February 7, 2017 in Winston-Salem, North Carolina. He lived most recently in Pfafftown, a small community that is part of Winston-Salem, after spending most of his life in New Jersey.

Bayard came to Dartmouth after serving as an enlisted man in the U.S. Marine Corps. He was a member of Delta Upsilon fraternity and of Dartmouth's Reserve Officers Training Corps. Following graduation he spent three years in the U.S Navy as a Lieutenant (jg) on a destroyer.

His professional life was spent as a software engineer and senior scientific programmer.
