JEREMY C. LINDSAY

Jeremy C. Lindsay died in Bellevue, Washington on January 8, 2017 after a long illness.

Survivors include his wife of 65 years, Madeline, 3 children and 2 grandchildren.

Jerry grew up in Boston and attended Kimball Union Academy before enrolling at Dartmouth. As an undergraduate he majored in history and was a member of Phi Gamma Delta fraternity and the Press Club.

Soon after graduation Jerry and Madeline moved to the Pacific Northwest where he joined his father and grandfather as an owner and manager of Lindsay's Thrifty Store, an independent regional grocery store. The business was sold in the late 1970's, after which Jerry made a major career shift, pursuing his lifelong interest in the stock market by becoming a broker with Waddell and Reed. He later moved to Freeman Welwood & Co., a regional discount brokerage, from which he retired in 2002.

Sports were a life-long love. Jerry closely followed professional teams in every sport from both Boston and Seattle. He enjoyed playing golf for most of his adult life. He and Madeline were also enthusiastic travelers . In his community Jerry was a contributive member of the Kiwanis Club and served as its president.
