

## Obituary ALEX X. SARJEANT

Alex X. Sarjeant, who joined the class of '51 after six years as a radioman in the U.S. Navy, died on August 19, 2009 in Kent Connecticut.

Alex was married and lived in Wigwam Village throughout his years as a Dartmouth undergraduate. He later described his years as an older student as untypical and somewhat apart from his classmates but nonetheless added "My Dartmouth years were perhaps the most consequential part of my life."

He spent his business career in the dental equipment industry, first as a salesman and later as a manufacturers' representative. He retired to Florida in 1990 and lived there for 25 years before moving to Connecticut at the end of his life to be near family.

Alex is survived by 4 children, 6 grandchildren and one great-grandchild. His wife Joan predeceased him as did one son who lost his life in the Vietnam war.
