

Obituary Norman V. Wagner II

Norman V. Wagner II, known as "Vic" in his undergraduate years, died in Oceanside, California on March 23, 2014. He came to Dartmouth from Rocky River, Ohio, stayed through his sophomore year and transferred to the University of California, Los Angeles, from which he graduated in 1951. He spent the rest of his life in southern California.
