"David J. Garrett, age 70, died Tuesday, October 17, 2006, at home. A native of University Heights, OH, Mr. Garrett had lived in the Wilmington area for the past 28 years. He practiced law in Cleveland, Baltimore and Wilmington, retiring as a partner of Potter, Anderson & Corroon in Wilmington. Since retiring from the law firm, he taught at the University of Delaware and worked in fundraising for the United Way of Delaware.

A graduate of Dartmouth College and the University of Michigan Law School, he also taught at the University of Maryland Law School and Widener University School of Law. Mr. Garrett served in the U.S. Navy, where he reached the rank of Lieutenant Junior Grade.

He is survived by his sons, Charles D. Garrett of Woodinville, WA and Richard V. Garrett of Richmond, VA; a step-daughter, Alice K. Fulweiler of Wilmington, DE; a step-son, William L. Kitchel III of Swarthmore, PA; a sister, Mary Martha Miller of Pinehurst, NC; a brother, Michael Garrett of ME; and 4 step-grandchildren. His wife, Mary Potter Garrett, died in 2004.
