- A session with alumni who were awarded the Arts Initiative student prize at the Hopkins Center. (The awardees from the Dickey and Hopkins Centers are now fully funded through the Robert Frost Endowment, which our class funded over the past five years)
- A Memorial Service in honor of our deceased classmates, led by the Reverend George Bland.
- A women's session for Spouses and Widows, led by Nyla Arslanian and Patti Rich.
- A classmate panel of varsity athletes during our four years, and how athletics has influenced their lives after graduation.
- A classmate panel of authors with interesting stories to tell (no pun intended).
- Two sessions, each with three classmates, who will relate interesting and unique careers, hobbies, adventures, and involvement to make the World a better place.
- Several short slideshows of artwork by our classmates, including one with art of our deceased classmates, following the Memorial Service.
- A class meeting, led by President Don O'Neill, to elect officers for the next five years and to raffle off the Tanzi license plate.
- Several break-out sessions just for mingling, schmoozing, and catching up with each other's' lives.
- A concert by the Dartmouth Aires

Each day, we will start at 12:00 noon, Eastern Time, and end by 4:45 to 5:45, including breaks.
