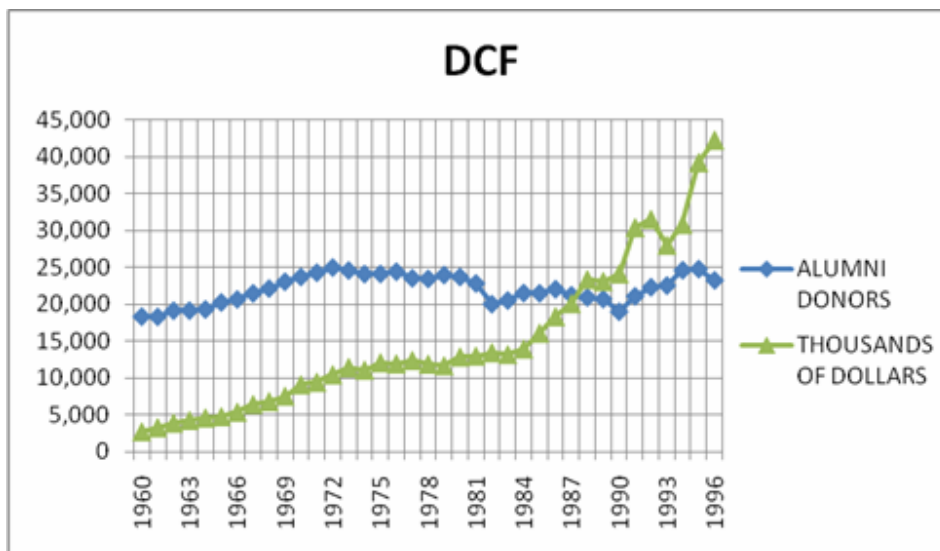


DCF 2009 Results

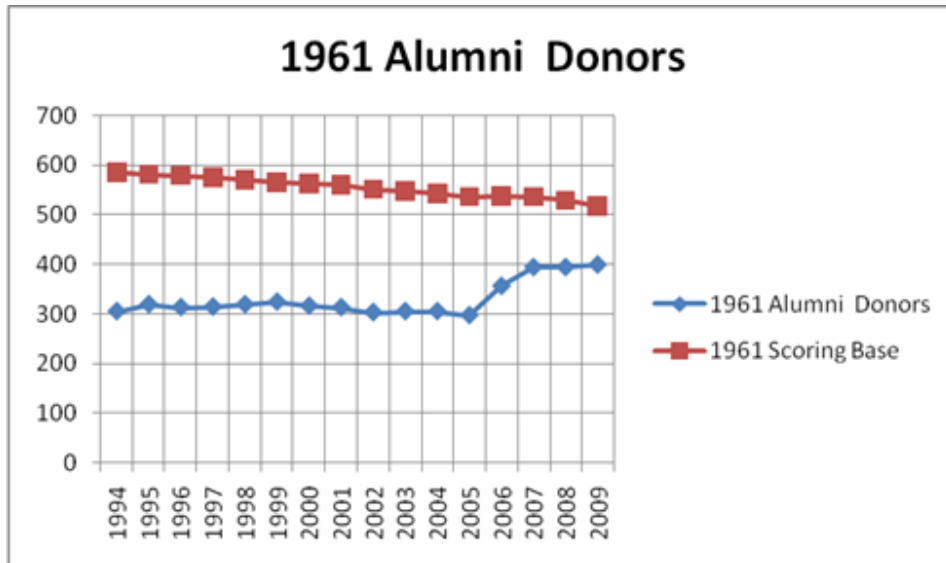
We had a great year!

Here are the results for the 2009 fund year ended June 30.

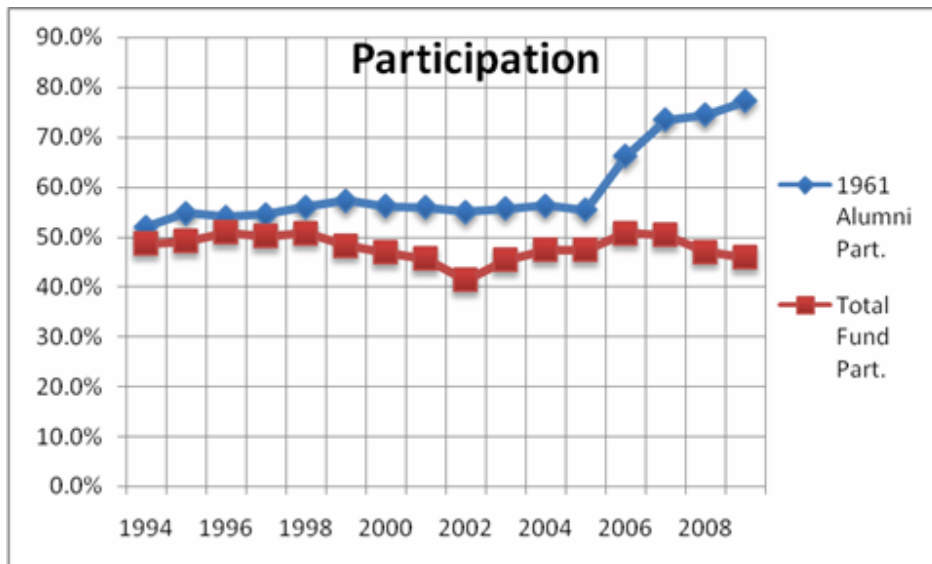
The overall Dartmouth College Fund raised a record \$42,188,000 from 25,825 donors. The chart below shows the record of alumni donors and dollars for the fund as a whole since 1960.



The Class of 1961 achieved a stunning level of participation with a lot of hard work by our 52 classmates who serve as volunteer solicitors and the generosity and spirit of participation by 399 classmates, 34 of whom had not contributed the year before. So we continued the increase in contributors that we started in our 45th reunion year of 2006, as shown in the chart below, even though our base continued to shrink.



As a result, we increased our participation to 77.2%, up from 74.5% last year, as shown below, in contrast to the downward trend for the Fund as a whole. In fact, we have increased our participation in the last three years while the fund declined in each of the last three years.



We actually exceeded the participation rate of all classes except for the following:

1954 86.2%

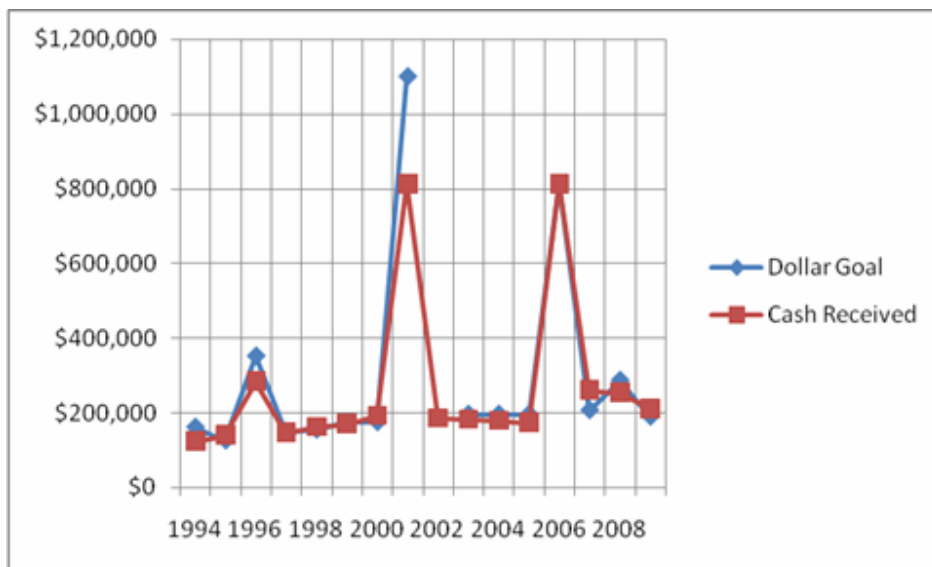
1960 83.6%

1944 81.1%

1959 80.8%

All of these except 1960 are reunion classes, and 1960 will have their 50th next year.

We also exceeded our \$190,000 goal, raising \$211,143 in a difficult year economically. The dollar results are below, with bulges showing in our reunion years:
