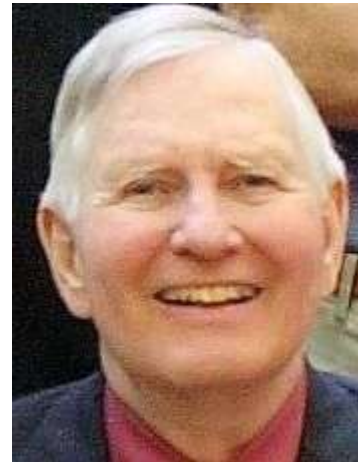


# George H. Breed

## Obituary

Mr. George Herbert Breed, age 75, of Jackson, WY, passed away of idiopathic pulmonary fibrosis on June 4 in Murray, Utah, in peace and comfort with loved ones at his side.
