

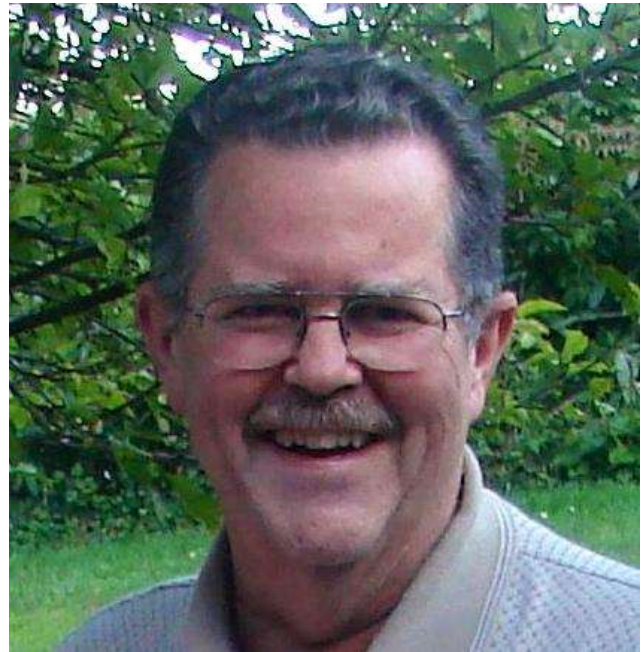
Bill Cogswell
