Bob was born in Long Beach, California 1939. He and his mother soon moved to San Diego to welcome his father back from the war. In 1979, he transferred to Gulf's European Headquarters in London, England, then transferred back to Texas in 1983, at which point he took an early retirement. In 1998, he and his wife moved to San Diego, California, where they spent the next twenty years. They moved back to Texas in 2018.
