

Ragnar Aagard

Died: March 22, 2008

Ragnar died at the age of 70 on Saturday, March 22, 2008. To the best of our knowledge, he was living in Sweden at the time.

Very little is known about Ragnar, both before and after he left Dartmouth. There is no entry for him in The Green Book.

The Aegis records that his major was English and that in his junior and senior years he was a member of the Film Society and the Cosmopolitan Club. He was also a member of the Outing Club his senior year. He graduated with our class in June 1961. At that time his home address was listed as Oslo, Norway.

From that point onward, Ragnar's career and life is largely uncharted in college archives.

In 1996 he reportedly worked for a municipality north of Stockholm known as Sandvikens Kommun. His spouse at the time was named "Gun." A Google search plausibly identifies him as the author of a 1996 thesis, entitled "Man, Motion, and Movement: A Study of Theme in William Faulkner's 'The Unvanquished,' " and other publications, some relating to intercultural teacher development, but none can be confirmed.

As of 2001, his last known address, noted in the 40th Reunion Yearbook published in that year, was Spikasvagen 35, S-81832 Valbo Swede, Sweden.
