Pete died at his home on Thursday, June 26, 2003, in Omaha, where he had lived for many years after he left Dartmouth before graduating. He was 63 years old.

He entered Dartmouth from Scarsdale, New York, where he went to high school and was an honors student, on the student council, and in the band and dramatics club. At Dartmouth he was a member of the marching and concert band. The author remembers him as dedicated to the craft of writing. He was a freshman year roommate of Dick Bailey and Skip Barnett.

Pete's brother John (a member of the class of 1957) writes that Pete "left Dartmouth during his junior year and did not graduate. He started his career as a reporter for the local newspaper in Scarsdale, N.Y. He moved to Omaha in 1964 and was a columnist for several Omaha newspapers. He also appeared on local television as an entertainment and food commentator. Peter never married."
