

## **Leonard Daniel Donovan**

Died: May 4, 1990

Len died on Friday, May 4, 1990, at age 50 after a short illness in Massachusetts General Hospital in Boston.

He grew up in Watertown, Massachusetts, and in high school there was in the national honor society, on the student council, played golf, and was editor-in-chief of the school yearbook.

At Dartmouth he was a member of Kappa Kappa Kappa (he became its treasurer), was active in dormitory and fraternity government, and during his first two years active in the Newman Club and on the Aegis staff. He graduated from the Tuck School of Business in 1962.

After 16 years with Norton Company in Worcester, Massachusetts, and becoming vice-president and general manager there, he acquired his own business in 1983, "after a long search and negotiations," he writes. It was Specialty Aluminum Inc., located near Logan Airport, and (he wrote) "all of our products are custom made to each customer's specifications. It's a unique business with an excellent potential for growth."

There is no further record of him in any of our previous reunion publications, other than his residence in 1986 in Southborough, Massachusetts. Len left behind one daughter, Kelly.
