Died: May 24, 2001

John died in Charlotte, North Carolina on Thursday, May 24, 2001, at age 62. His death was reportedly sudden.

He grew up in Hempstead, New York, and graduated with honors from high school there, was on the student council and the school newspaper, was co-captain of the football team, and on the track team. He was also senior class president.

At Dartmouth John majored in German and pre-med and was a member of Psi Upsilon. He was on the football team as a freshman, and on the swimming team his freshman and sophomore years. He was in the Newman Club for three years, and for one year was in Germania, the German club. After Dartmouth, he went on to earn an M.S. degree in anatomy and a D.D.S. degree from Harvard.

John became an orthodontist, working at the University of Pennsylvania Dental School, serving an internship (with the United States Army) at Walter Reed Hospital, and a residency in orthodontics at the University of North Carolina. Thereafter, he was in private practice of orthodontics in Charlotte, North Carolina.

Over the years John was very active in Alumni affairs, in the areas of enrollment, and giving, and as a club president. He had two sons, John and Scott, and a daughter Terri.
