Died: November 29, 1972

Ed died at age 34 in Austria on Wednesday, November 29, 1972. He had been living in Gmunden, Austria and was teaching at the American School of Vienna.

He came to Dartmouth from Upper Montclair, New Jersey, and had graduated from Deerfield Academy in Western Massachusetts. While there, he had served on the school newspaper, and been a member of the glee club and manager of the track team. His grandfather was in the Dartmouth class of 1892, and his father in the class of 1934.

An Alumni Magazine obituary for Ed, appearing in February 1973, notes that "the College infirmary, Dick's House, was given by his grandfather in memory of Ed's uncle, Dick Hall, Class of 1927."

The obituary continues, reporting, "While at Dartmouth Ed became a member of Alpha Delta Phi. Not much is known about his other campus activities, because he left Dartmouth after two years. He went to Europe and became proficient in several languages. Ed taught language and history in several American Schools, in Paris, London, Madrid, and Munich."

Ed had two sons, Christian and Eric.
