Dave died in his sleep at his Denver home at age 69 on Monday, January 26, 2009.

He grew up on the Main Line outside Philadelphia, in Wynnewood, Pennsylvania, where he went to high school. He was in the honor society there, captain of the rifle team, and manager of the soccer team. At Dartmouth he was a pre-med student, active in dormitory government, on the rifle team for his first three years, in the film society for one year, in the outing club for all four years, and involved his freshman year in the carnival and Bait & Bullet.

He graduated from Dartmouth Medical School in 1962 and Harvard Medical School in 1964, and trained in anesthesiology. He served as a Lt. Commander in the Navy from 1968 to 1970.

He moved to Denver in 1970 with his family, and practiced medicine there in the field of anesthesiology for the next 35 years, until his retirement 2005.

Dave married his wife Roberta (Bobbie) in 1965, and they had five children, David, Wendy, Rebecca, Christopher, and Charlie.
