Pete died of cancer on Saturday, September 28, 2002. He was 65 years old.

He grew up in Montreal, and went to Bishops College School in Sherbrooke, Quebec, about 100 miles to the east. He was an honors student there, sang in the choir, and was captain of both the hockey and football teams. He also played cricket there.

At Dartmouth ... well, let Tom Conger, our class chronicler of such things, tell it. "Pete came to us from Montreal, and played freshman hockey. He had apparently served in the military between prep school and Dartmouth. He left after freshman year, and returned north, having given me the impression that we young pups vexed him with our impetuous naiveté."

No other information has been made available about his career after leaving Dartmouth, or concerning the circumstances of his death. For three years in the late 1960's, according to his family, he worked in Jamaica as the manager of the Jamaica Hilton Hotel. Perhaps signaling a vestigial interest in the college, however, he reliably, for all our reunions — the 25th, the 35th, and the 40th in 2001 — had sent us his mailing address in Montreal, which he evidently considered his home base and where for some of the time, at least, he had been living.
