

Harry Berlin Solmson III

Died: January 17, 1987

Harry died Saturday, January 17, 1987 of an apparent heart attack at his Boca Raton, Florida, home. He was 47 years old.

He grew up in Memphis, and went to Christian Brothers High School, where in successive years he served as class secretary and class president. He was elected to the national honor society and served on the class yearbook. He was on the golf and swimming teams.

At Dartmouth he majored in economics and was a member of Sigma Chi fraternity. He served on the staff of the Aegis his freshman year, and was in the outing club all four years.

After graduating, according to an Alumni Magazine obituary, Harry became executive vice-president of Plough, Inc., a manufacturer of toiletries, medicines, and cosmetics, and of which (in its later incarnation as Schering-Plough Corporation) his father was a former president and director.

Harry was active in alumni affairs, said the obituary, especially in Memphis, where at different times he served as secretary and as president from the years 1963-1969.

In addition to his corporate position, Harry managed some farm properties in eastern Arkansas, said the obituary. Only his address is published in our 25th Reunion Yearbook.

He had two children, Elizabeth and Ellen.
