## Moonoka Begay, Arts Initiative Awardee

As you will recall, the Class of '61 has provided financial support to a student (or students) in the Arts each year since 2002, under the Arts Initiative program. Any Dartmouth student can apply for the grant, describing their project and estimating the costs involved that would be reimbursed by the award. Originally funded directly from the Class treasury, the awards are now paid from the Robert Frost Endowment Fund, created during the years leading up to our 60<sup>th</sup> reunion.

This year, our awardee is **Moonoka Begay**, a '23 multimedia artist from Oakland, CA., double majoring in Studio Art and Native American and Indigenous Studies. In her work she explores themes of indigenous identity, romance, states of wilderness, queer love, rebellion and the body. She is attracted by candy colors, dreamlike visuals, earthen textures and imperfect beauty. Her current love affair is with sculpture. Moonoka has been developing a sculptural exhibit of personal work titled **Semi Precious** in which she presents her Indigenous heritage through a material lens.

This year she is working as the intern of Native American art at the Hood Museum and, in the future, plans to continue to honor Indigenous narratives by immersing herself in the realm of contemporary Native American art. She will be using the money from our award for material costs such as plaster, paint, lumber, gems, clay, and casting supplies.

Moonoka's parents are both Dartmouth graduates and will be attending our hyflex session in Hanover.
