# **Zoom Connections and Etiquette:**

As we've said previously, we recommend that you check to see that you have the latest version of Zoom before the session.

When you join a Zoom session the name associated with your image is usually your first and last name. Sometimes, people show up with something like "Sam's iPad" or "Joe" so we may not know who you are. Please change by clicking "Participants" at the bottom of the screen. A list of participants will appear at the right of your screen. Click on "more" next to your name, click "rename" and make the change. Then hit "return."

You may join the mini-reunion as early as 12:30 PM Eastern and join informal conversation with other early bird classmates. Using "gallery view" during the first ½ hour will allow you to see others who have signed in. When the formal program begins, we recommend you switch to "speaker view" so you'll easily see the panelists and moderators.

### **Question and Answer Sessions:**

When the session officially begins at 1:00 PM Eastern, all participants will be muted by the Host. Please stay muted throughout. During the Q&A portions of the program, please raise your "digital hand" if you have question or wish to make a comment. Here's how this works:

- At the bottom of the zoom screen, click on the button that says "Reactions."
- Then, click on the icon that shows a hand and the words "Raise Hand."
- Wait until the Session Moderator recognizes you, then unmute yourself and ask your question or make a comment.
- When you have finished, click on the icon that now reads "Lower Hand," and mute yourself.

If you prefer, you may make your comment or ask your question in the Chat Function.

## **Dedication of Frost's Mending Wall:**


