

## 1962 Obituary Dartmouth Alumni Magazine

**Anthony Robert Vetrone** died suddenly on October 19, 2008, at his 50th East Haven High School class reunion in Rocky Hill, Connecticut. At the time of his death, Bob was a permanent resident of Hahira, Georgia, near Valdosta. Although he matriculated with the class of 1962, Bob left Dartmouth from 1960 to 1963 to serve with the U. S. Army in Europe but returned to graduate in 1965. After Dartmouth he worked in human resource management for Uniroyal and Uniroyal-Goodrich Tire Company, rising to division manager in Human Resource with Bridgestone/Firestone in Oklahoma City from 1988 to 1992. An athlete himself in the 1950s, in retirement Bob became involved in substitute teaching at Lowndes High School in Valdosta, Georgia, where he was known as “Mr. Bob,” a much-loved booster of the school’s athletics programs. He is survived by his wife Barbara, two daughters and sons-in-law, two stepchildren, and two grandchildren.
