By Charitable Gift Annuity

The Charitable Gift Annuity is a simple contract between you and Dartmouth. In exchange for assets irrevocably transferred to the College for an eventual purpose like the Class of 1962 Writing and Rhetoric Endowment, you and/or another beneficiary receive regular fixed payments for life, backed by the resources of the College. Annuity payments, based on annuitants' ages, include tax-free, ordinary, and (if the gift is of appreciated securities) capital gain income distributed over time. Also, a charitable tax deduction for a portion of the gift value is available on your income tax return in the year of the gift.
