Allan Charles Coggeshall died suddenly on November 4, 1969. A graduate of Pleasantville, N.Y., High School, Allan majored in philosophy at Dartmouth. He served on the staffs of the "Dartmouth" and WDCR. Allan was also active in the Outing Club, Le Cercle Francais, and in the Dartmouth Christian Union Political Action Committee. During his senior year he was a Senior Fellow. In October, 1964 he worked with the Student Nonviolent Coordinating Committee in Jackson, Mississippi, where he was one of the participants who were arrested for 'passing out handbills without a permit.'
