Cliff came to Dartmouth from Oceanside (N.Y.) High School, where he was a member of the National Honor Society and active with the school newspaper, the yearbook, and drama club, where he was part of the stage crew and an actor. He was majoring in government and planned to become a lawyer.

During his abbreviated time at Dartmouth, Cliff was a member of the Players and he appeared in "The Pajama Game" as a freshman. He was also active in the DOC, intramural sports, the Jewish Life Council and a brother of Sigma Phi Epsilon, where he was the house director.

During an early spring outing on the Connecticut River, the canoe in which Cliff and two Sigma Phi brothers were riding capsized. In spite of efforts by his fraternity brothers to rescue him, Cliff drowned.
