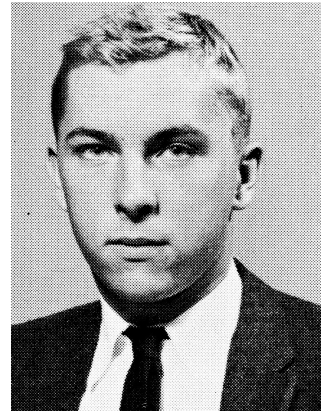


John Richard Lazarek
