Phil came to Dartmouth from Washburn High School, Minneapolis, Minnesota, where he was in the National Honor Society.

At Dartmouth he was a member of the Glee Club and a brother of Alpha Chi Alpha. Phil was an outstanding student who majored in Engineering Science. He received faculty commendations in both art and engineering, graduated magna cum laude and Phi Beta Kappa. He continued at Thayer, where he earned an M.S. in 1966. After Dartmouth he went to the University of Michigan where he earned a Ph.D. in Nuclear Engineering. He was a licensed professional engineer in Michigan and a member of the American Nuclear Society.



He was socially active and participated in Crescent Hills Civic Club and in his church choir. He worked for 28 years for Westinghouse Nuclear Safety. He was retired on total disability in 1998. Phil left his wife Jean and two children.
