#### **Accepted Student Reception - Cleveland Racquet Club**

From a total of 20,504 applicants, Dartmouth offered 2,120 Students acceptance into the Class of 2019 (10.3% acceptance rate). This class will graduate when Dartmouth celebrates the 250<sup>th</sup> anniversary of its founding.

The students' SAT scores averaged in the 98<sup>th</sup> percentile nationwide and 95 percent of them rank in the top 10 percent of their high school graduating class, 38.4% are valedictorians and 10.1 % are salutatorians. 15% of them are first generation to attend college .
