Her "Solutions for Women" seminars aim to enlighten women on investing, financial planning, and socially responsible philanthropic giving. Heather is widely recognized for her unique expertise, experience, and dedication to helping other women build their financial acumen and wealth; both in her professional practice and community involvement. Most recently, she co-authored a study of over 550 women in 44 states entitled "Women of Wealth: Why Does the Financial Services Industry Still Not Hear Them?"

She will emphasize why women should be deliberate in considering these issues, and should take hold of their own asset management.
