Dartmouth has partnered with edX , a nonprofit online learning platform founded by Harvard and MIT . The first course will launch early 2015.

Details follow: “Professors will engage with the edX course during the initial run time, generally six weeks, and then the course will operate independently on the site. The DartmouthX classes will be free and open to anyone, and will not be part of the Dartmouth curriculum.”
