I am delighted to present an annual update on our Club's Scholarship Fund Program. Our Club's ten scholarship funds generated approximately \$221,000 in scholarship funds during 2010-2011, supporting thirteen students from our Midwest Club region. The overall value of the funds stand at approximately \$4.1 million.
